Thanks in large part to the assistance of Julia Williams at MRSPA, who is continuing to work with us and our printer and mailer with monthly updates of new members, deaths, and address changes. Last September, when we began to revise our member-list, we printed and mailed 1160 ECHOES. As of January 2nd, we printed and mailed 861 ECHOES. This is a drop of 299! COMMUNITY SERVICE


